<b>501</b>	<b>STUDENT ATTENDANCE</b>
<b>501.3</b>	<b>Interruptions in Student Attendance</b>

The Board of Education, School District No. 48 (Sea to Sky) recognizes that there may be circumstances from time to time that interrupt student attendance at school. Such circumstances may include:

1. Inclement Weather

It is expected that students will attend schools in times of inclement weather. The exception to this expectation may be in times of heavy snowfall when the operation of the buses is not practicable. This circumstance is defined Policy and Regulation No. 701.4, Interruption of Bus Service: Inclement Weather, governing the operation of the school buses.

2. Emergency Situations

There may be times when a school has to be evacuated and students sent home due to an emergency situation with the school facility or in the community. The circumstances in this instance are defined in Policy and Regulation No. 903.4, Emergency Preparedness, governing the school physical plants.

3. Health Concerns

There may be times when a student, or students, is not required to attend school due a health concern with the individual or with the community. The circumstances governing this situation is defined in Policy and Regulation No. 504.6, Communicable Diseases, governing communicable diseases.
