<b>605.5</b>	<b>Research Projects</b>

The Board of Education, School District No. 48 (Sea to Sky), recognizes the role of valid research and other projects in the development of educational theories and practices and acknowledges the need of researchers to work within the schools.

Before research and other projects are considered for approval by the Board, they must be sponsored and supervised by a recognized post-secondary educational institution or a recognized research institute, or must be a component of approved research by district personnel.

Research projects must have the support of the Human Ethics Committees or of committees with similar responsibilities at the respective institutions.

Consideration will also be given to the number of research and other projects that are underway in the district at a given time.

This policy does not apply to routine Ministry or approved school district assessment practices.

The Regulation accompanying this Policy provides direction on requests for research projects, studies or questionnaires involving students in the district.
