

The Board of Education, School District No. 48 (Sea to Sky), supports and encourages parents and interested public to visit the schools.

However, in the interest of safety for students and employees and of security for school district property, individuals must first report to the school administration office.

In circumstances where the behaviour of individuals disrupts or interrupts the proceedings of a school or an official school function, the *School Act* provides for the maintenance of order.

MAINTENANCE OF ORDER

Section 177 of the *School Act* addresses the preservation of order on school premises, including ordering a person to leave and calling in police help if necessary. Section 177 of the *School Act* reads as follows:

- (1) A person must not disturb or interrupt the proceedings of a school or an official school function.
- (2) A person who is directed to leave the land or premises of a school by a Principal, Vice-Principal, Director of Instruction or a person authorized by the board to make that direction;
 - (a) must immediately leave the land and premises, and
 - (b) must not enter on the land and premises again except with prior approval from the Principal, Vice-Principal, Director of Instruction or a person who is authorized by the board to give that approval.
- (3) A person who contravenes subsection (1) or (2) commits an offence.
- (4) A Principal, Vice-Principal or Director of Instruction of a school or a person authorized by the Board may, in order to restore order on school premises, require adequate assistance from a peace officer.

Title

This bylaw may be cited as "School District No. 48 (Sea to Sky) Intruders on School Property Bylaw No. 903.1-2016".

Repeal

School District No. 48 (Sea to Sky) Intruders on School Property Bylaw No. 903.1.1 is hereby repealed
