

The Board of Education is responsible for maintaining a safe and healthy learning environment at all schools and School District sites.

In School District No. 48 (Sea to Sky), Municipal and Squamish Lillooet Regional District bylaws, with respect to animal control, will apply to all School District property and school sites.

Specifically, all dogs must be kept on a leash, tether, or other suitable device, and under the immediate care and control of a competent person. In the event a dog defecates on school district property, the competent person in control of the dog must immediately remove and dispose of the feces in a sanitary manner.

Each school principal will meet annually with the Parent Advisory Council and staff to review this policy and/or establish further local guidelines.

Notwithstanding this policy, under the School Act, the principal of the school has the authority to remove any person / animal which poses a safety or health concern to the school learning environment.
