## REGULATION SERIES 500 - STUDENT PERSONNEL

### R 501            STUDENT ATTENDANCE R 501.7        Students Over School Age

This Regulation specifies the definition, level of support and conditions under which a person over school age may be provided with an educational program.

#### 1.     Definition of School Age

According to the *School Act*, Section 1, "school age means the age between the date on which a person is permitted under Section 3 (1) to enroll in an educational program provided by the Board and the end of the school year in which the person reaches the age of 19 years

#### 2.     Level of Support

The Board of Education will provide tuition-free basic education to persons over school age through the Distributed Learning program and in some cases secondary schools, in accordance with the conditions noted below.

#### 3.     Conditions of Enrollment

- 3.1     The student has attained the prior approval of the Distributed Learning, or secondary school principal, or school district designate.
- 3.2     The student agrees to comply with the District and School Code of Conducts. Violation of the Codes may lead to removal from the educational program.
- 3.3     The student has provided evidence (report card, transcript, and other pertinent documents) that indicate a reasonable chance of success in the course (s) to be attempted.
