R502. STUDENT CONDUCT

R502.6 Cyber-misconduct

Regulations:

1. Cyber-misconduct

The district will not tolerate the publication, via computer and/or other multi-media devices (cell phones, cameras, Blackberries, etc.) of material that creates, or is likely to create, an environment which negatively impacts or causes significant disruption to the school and/or:

- 1.1 Is abusive, demeaning, hateful or insulting, or
- 1.2 Is threatening, bullying or intimidating, or
- 1.3 Incites harmful behaviour towards others, or
- 1.4 Discriminates or harasses on the basis of race, religion, sex, sexual orientation, disability or for any other reason set out in the Human Rights Code of British Columbia.

2. Response

- 2.1 The school will investigate and take action, as appropriate, in situations where such material is published:
 - 2.1.1 Through networks hosted by the school district
 - 2.1.2 Through other networks and electronic communication devices if, in the opinion of the Principal, the behaviour will have an impact on the school environment.
- 2.2 Students who violate this regulation will be subjected to discipline policy and regulations as outlined in regulations R 502.2 and/or R 502.3 and the school's code of conduct.
