R 504.6 Communicable Diseases

This Regulation supports the Policy with respect to students regarding communicable diseases.

- 1. The Board, in accordance with Sections 100 and 107 of the *School Act*, may, on recommendation of the School Medical Officer, suspend a student in its responsibility to protect other students and employees from exposure to communicable diseases.
- 2. The recommendation of the School Medical Officer is the basis for the Board's decision as to whether a student is suspended from school.
- 3. For specific Communicable Diseases such as AIDS or Hepatitis B, procedures addressing the reporting of suspected cases; the creation of appropriate educational settings; the protection of staff and students; and the confidentiality of personnel and records are included in the Administrative Procedures under Series 400; 405 Employment Conditions; 405.7 Communicable Diseases.
