R 504.6 **Communicable Diseases**

This Regulation supports the Policy with respect to students regarding communicable diseases.

1. The Board, in accordance with Sections 100 and 107 of the *School Act*, may, on recommendation of the School Medical Officer, suspend a student in its responsibility to protect other students and employees from exposure to communicable diseases.
2. The recommendation of the School Medical Officer is the basis for the Board's decision as to whether a student is suspended from school.
3. For specific Communicable Diseases such as AIDS or Hepatitis B, procedures addressing the reporting of suspected cases; the creation of appropriate educational settings; the protection of staff and students; and the confidentiality of personnel and records are included in the Administrative Procedures under Series 400; 405 Employment Conditions; 405.7 Communicable Diseases.
