New Programs considered will:

1. Have a clearly articulated Program Rationale.
2. Reflect parental and or staff desire for programs with a particular educational emphasis.
3. Fulfill a recognized educational experience separate from existing programs and services.
4. Be free from any religious affiliation.
5. Be consistent with Board policies.
6. Be funded at the same levels with respect to resources and staff as those levels established for elementary and secondary schools / grades / programs.

Any additional costs for establishing or maintaining the Program will be the responsibility of the school. A complete description of any anticipated outside funding will be provided by the school – whether from government, corporate, private or other sources, and any requirements connected with such funding – will be provided by the school and will require Board approval.

7. Conform with collective agreements.
8. Identify the potential school locations and the impact of the proposed program on other classes, students, and school culture within the school.
9. Identify the potential impact on other schools in the District.
10. Not adversely affect operational needs of the School District.
11. Be available to all students in School District 48 (Sea to Sky), and be housed in facilities where space permits and which are suitable to the Program.
12. Be maintained without transportation assistance from the Board.
13. Be subject to planning and recruiting schedules established by the district.
14. Be subject to evaluation on an ongoing basis by the Board.
