R 605	ASSESSMENT & EVALUATION
R 605.5	Research Projects

This Regulation provides direction on requests for research projects, studies or questionnaires involving students in the district.

1. Preference will be given to recognized provincial institutions such as the universities, British Columbia School Trustees' Association or Ministries of the provincial government.
2. Preference will be given to approval of projects which will provide knowledge and that will improve educational programs for School District No. 48 students.
3. Low priority will be given to individuals who are conducting a study as part of a graduate program unless the administration considers the information to be of importance.
4. The principal of the school has the authority to approve requests specific to the school according to the above priorities unless the request is contentious and controversial. In such cases, the request must be referred to the Superintendent for Board review.
5. If the request applies to more than one school, it should be directed to the Superintendent of Schools.
6. If approval is granted, the following conditions must be met:
 - 6.1 Approval of the school principal, in writing
 - 6.2 Written parent permission must be obtained
 - 6.3 Confidentiality must be ensured
 - 6.4 Students must have the option of not participating
 - 6.5 Any final report must be made available to the school or district
