

The Board of Education, School District No. 48 (Sea to Sky) believes that the position of a school trustee is an honour and an opportunity to provide service to the respective communities and to the children in the district.

The Board also believes that it is a reasonable expectation that trustees receive remuneration for this service. The *School Act, Section 71*, makes provision for the payment of remuneration to trustees and further, allows that the remuneration for the Chairperson and Vice-Chairperson may be greater than for the other trustees.

Effective December 1, 2018:

1. The annual remuneration for Trustees will be:
 - Trustee elected in Squamish Lillooet Regional District-Area C \$14,171
 - Trustee elected in the Village of Pemberton \$13,797
 - Trustee elected in the Resort Municipality of Whistler \$12,939
 - Trustee elected in the District of Squamish \$11,480
 - Trustee elected in Squamish Lillooet Regional District-Area D \$11,680

In addition the Chairperson will receive an additional \$4,000 per annum and the Vice-Chairperson will receive an additional \$1,000 per annum.

2. The remuneration shall be paid in regular monthly installments.
3. One-third of the-remuneration shall be a non-vouchered expense allowance as provided for in the *Income Tax Act*.
4. Every two years, starting November 1, 2016:
 - the remuneration checklist is completed. (See AP 205.3)
 - the application of Statistics Canada British Columbia Provincial Consumer Price Index (Annual average index) from the previous two years be used as the formula for a trustee compensation increase to be effective December 1, of that year.
